Objective:

First, I would like you to write the title for this assignment. Look at the reading passage "The Sacred Grove Oshogbo" once again. Your sentence on line 1 is not the description of Pastor Paul. Do you the difference between an objective paragraph and a subjective paragraph? An objective paragraph is a paragraph that is the same as the text. It means that other students will get the same information or read the same things about what you have described. While a subjective paragraph is a paragraph that is according to your opinion, idea, feeling, so it means that other students will get different information or read different things about what you have described. Ok. The phrase "with his brown skin" on line 3 and the phrase "..., especially when he was smiling" on line 4 are not an objective paragraph but a subjective one. Here, you can add other information about Pastor Paul, for example "He was a Nigerian man," "He came from a church in Benue State," etc.

Subjective:

Your subjective is right, but can you make it longer than this? You can describe his appearances from the head until the feet. Besides, you can also describe about his characters, your feeling when you saw him, etc. Please you look at line 2 for the phrase "and not fat" is not right. You should make it into a new sentence. My suggestion of this is you can make that phrase into "He was not fat because he did not like to eat much." Your organization is also not precise. You should mention all about Pastor Paul appearance first, and then you go a long with his characters.

Ok that's all my feedback for your first assignment. Now, your job is to revise it. When you still have a problem, you can record your questions. Good Luck!

STUDENT THREE

Objective:

Your description is right, clear, and good enough. Where is your title? There are some mistakes here. First, I want to remember you that you must be consistent with your tenses that you used. It's better for you to use Simple Past. Now, change your tense on line 1, the sentence: "Pastor Paul is young but a belly was already spreading..." in the Past form. And this is the same with your sentence on line 4-"He has brow wrinkling..." For your sentence on line 5-"Paul is very fat it can be seen from his physical performance" should be deleted it, because this is a repetition of line 1 and 2 "Pastor Paul was young but his belly was already spreading under his white Izod shirt." As a suggestion, you can add information there, for example "He was a Nigerian man," "He came from a church in Benue State."

Subjective:

Your subjective paragraph is original. Good job. However, you have some mistakes there. Look at line 1; change the preposition "with" with "to." See line 2, when you write a new sentence, you must write the first letter of your first word with a capital letter, so change the letter "M" in the word "Most" in the capital letter. Still in the same line – line 2, what do you mean with this sentence "Most of them maybe have opinion..."? Remember if you use the word "maybe", so the next word should be noun. I think here you want to say "Most of them may have" Add the word "one" before the word "opinion," so the sentence is "Most of them may have one opinion, that is Pastor Paul is the Holy man. Go to line 3, the word "because" should be changed with "That is because" in order to make it clear. Still on line 3, look at the conjunction "that," change it with a subject pronoun "it" that refers to the clause "he likes to pray." Now, see line 4; look for the right conjunction to change "if". The word "closely" is an adverb word, whereas it should be an adjective word. See the different between adverbs and adjective in meaning. Consult your dictionary!

Now, you revise your work. If you still have a problem, you can record your questions, and then collect it with your revision. Good Luck Sherly!

And if the word "was" are you using present or past? Decide! Line 4, for the word "curtain." Do you have one curtain or two curtains? Use the right "to be" and don't use a verb like has. And since "purple" is already a color, you don't have to write "color," "and the motif is hello kitty" just write down like this way "with hello kitty motif" there is much shorter. Line 4 "At the left of", delete the preposition "of." Line 5, before the "TV set" change the definite article into an indefinite article "article a" because you're mentioning it for the first time. On line 5, before the word "size" you've to put "s" Why? It shows that the size is the size of the TV. And also put a "to be" after the word "desk" on line 6 and also once there, again if you can still see the material of the thing, then don't say "made

from" but "made of." Line 7, "comic books and VCD" plural/singular? Decide! "Up of" change into "About the" and the word "has" change it into the correct form of the simple present for the subject of the first person singular. Delete to be "is" going on with "hanging on the wall." See line 8, before the word "hello kitty" put an indefinite article. Line 9, "I'm very up to clock" that is the Indonesian expression, for the English expression you can say "I like it so much." Line 10, "I have" use again of the right form of the simple present of the subject of the first person singular. After the word "CD-case." You can delete the "to be is" just go on with "made of wood" not "made from." Still on line 10, you use "was" as your to be again decide which the tense, do you use simple present or simple past? Line 11, "with the CD and VCD," is it only one CD and VCD? And for the word "was" again decide your tense. Line 12, "Its" should be "It is." Again "made of wood" not "made form." Decide your tense for to be "was and made of wood" and then for the word "it has" delete them and change it into one active participle "having". Line 15, change "were" into Simple Present "there are." And also delete the phrase "in the room there was two beds" just directly put a comma after "two beds." So it will go like "Beside that there are two beds, my sister and I have the same room. Delete the word "because." Line 16, "Beside the beds," add another phrase, "on the other corner" to replace the phrase on line 15. Line 16, put "a to be" after the word "study desk" and again not "made from" but "made of." For the word "were" on line 18, decide your tense. "She uses the drawer" only one drawer or many drawers? Between line 18 and 18, "the drawers has a lock" or "o lock." Line 20 the word "was" decide your tense. Line 21, the word "the computer" just change it into the object pronoun "it". On line 21 still, change the verb "has" into a "to be" in the Simple Present according to the subject that is "the computer table" and since "gray" is a color, you don't have to write down "color" anymore and before the word "a drawer" put the verb "has". Line 22, change the verb "has" into a "to be" in present and again delete "color." Line 23. for the word "were" set your tense. Line 24, delete the two words "use to" because if you use "used to", you're referring something that you did in the past but now you don't do it again but if you still do it again now, don't use "use to". The mistake is the same for line 25, the word "use to" just delete them. Line 26, you've "I hang a clothes hanger" Combination between line 25 and 26, "it is made of metal and has a silver color." For the phrase "and has a silver color" delete it and then you can put the word "silver" before the word "clothes hanger," so it becomes "I hang a silver clothes hanger" full stop and "It" now put "a to be" before the word "made" because you're making a passive sentence there "It is made of metal full stop." Line 27, "I'm very room" once again that is the Indonesia expression change it into "I like my room very much." "I think" on line 27 you can change the indefinite article "a" with a definite article "the," so it becomes "the most comfortable place in the world," delete the phrase "for me" because you're already had there before that "I think" so you don't have to use "for me."

Ok Nani, now your job is to revise this composition and if you still have problems, you can record your questions and then give it to me with your revision.

I am very happy because now your description is original. Good work! Where is your title? Look at line 2, you are trying to compare the one elephant and the other two elephants there, so when you use a comparison, you must also use a comparative adjective, so that is not "big and old than" but "bigger and older than." Since you are comparing the one elephant with two other, so you have to use "the others" instead of "the other" and don't forget to put "a to be" before the verb "wearing" because that is in the present continuous. Delete the indefinite article before the word "glasses," because the word "glasses" mentions in plural form. On line 3, add "a full stop" after the word "professor," then delete "the comma" and the phrase "two of the elephants," and then change it into "The two others," that is to make it simple. On line 4, "they are male and female," you might like to add indefinite article before "male" and "female." Line 5, "uniform" or "uniforms"? See the subject, plural or singular? Add a definite article before the word "female," and you can see that on line 6 in where you have to put the word "the" before "male." Line 6 again, add "a comma" after the word "male" and delete the word "elephants." Change the preposition "in" into "on." How many "heads" there? One or more than ones, use the plural. On line7, put "a comma" after the word "smart elephant." Delete the word "so," because you have used "because they want to elephants," so you don't use "because" and "so" at the same sentence. Line 8 after the word "ask" you must add "an object pronoun" if you are talking about one big elephant, then maybe you can say "and ask him to teach how to have an inventive thinking," not "to be inventive thinking" but "to have an inventive thinking." Don't forget an indefinite article for "inventive thinking." I'm sure you can develop your ideas more, so it is better for you to describe clearer than this. You see the picture again.

Line 3, "steping" should be with two p "Stepping Where?" "Forward" or "backward." Change the conjunction "and" with "while" and the preposition "to" into "at." Line 4, put "command" into plural form and change to be "is" with the correct to be, because you are mentioning "two small elephants." On line 5, "elephant" should be in plural also the word "elephant" after "one of the" should be in plural "One of the

elephants." Line 6, replace the phrase "tail of the elephant" with "elephant's tail" and change the word "other" with "next." Add "small elephant" after the word "next" and for the word "holding too" change it into "doing the same to the small elephant in front of it." So the whole sentence will go like this one "One of the elephants is holding the big elephant's tail and the next small elephant is doing the same to the small elephant in front of it." On line 7, the word "friendship" usually after "seem", we use adjective, so find the adjective of the word "friendship." Again the word "steping" should be two p. And then line 8, "a place" what Place? Explain! And then for the word "interested," I think you have to change it into the active that is "interesting" or maybe you want to use another word like "nice" or "unique" and for the word "dress" because they are "three of them" may be you should make it in plural for the word "dress." Delete "the comma." For line 9, rephrase the sentence "their action like a fashion show" into something like "they look like doing a fashion show" that is more appropriate for the English expression. Line 10, omit the first sentence "in front line is a big elephant," because you have mentioned it in front. And then for the word "he" gives the real subject, that is "The big elephant." For the next line - line 11, delete the sentence "He wears a pair of glasses." Line 12, delete the word "sheet" and put and "s" after "hair." It's Ok because you have referring to the pieces of hair and then change the preposition "above" into "on," because the hair attaches to your head. Line 13, how many "ears" do you have? Put them in the plural and for the phrase "his trunk is" just delete it and don't forget to put an indefinite article before the word "very long trunk", so the sentence will go like "He has two big ears and a very long trunk full stop." Still on line 13, "He wears" remember on line 11 I told you to delete the sentence, now put the word "glasses" after "wears" and then add the word "and," so it will go like "He wears glasses after wears and a big coat." Now for line 14, is it "bottoms" or "buttons"? B-O-T-T-O-M or B-U-T-T-O-N. Line 15, "before he wears" change that with "under his coat" and then for the next one "other cloth," you don't say "cloth" because "cloth" means "KAIN." So you have to say maybe "a shirt." Delete the "to be is" on line 15 and 16. You don't have to use that one. For line 16, change the verb "bring" into the simple present form. Then the sentence on line 17, "He wears a big trousers and shoes" first delete the indefinite tarticle "article a" because you have "big trousers." and then for the whole sentence, I would like you to move the whole sentence into line 16 after the word "a tie" but still use the full stop. Line 18, put the word "female or girl" before "elephant." Then for the sentence "The elephant is a small girl" you can just omit that one. Line 19, put a phrase "on her" before the word "hair." Now I would like to ask you "Is it a ribbon on her hair or on her head?" "Is there hair or not?" After the phrase on her hair/on her head put a comma and add these words "a stripped with a double p shirt" comma "a skirt" comma "and shorts." Line 20, you don't say "hearing" usually "listening to the command" or "commands" Is it plural or singular. Line 21, delete the phrase "and her trunk until line 24 wears shoes." So start from 21 until 24 delete the phrase or sentences, start from "and" until "shoes." Line 24, "she has thin body." You just say "She is thin." For the next one How do you write "third"? Is it T-H-I-R-T-H or T-H-I-R-D? Line 25, "a hat" comma put another words there "a long-sleeved." S-L-Double E-V-E-D. "a

long-sleeved shirt" comma "a bow" comma "and shorts." Line 26, once how many "ears"? And then for the word "giving" it should be "paying" attention. Line 27, "he has fat" you can just say "He is fat." And you can delete the phrase "and his trunk up to elephant's tail" delete it. It is just a repetition you have mentioned it before. And for the next sentence "He wears long sleeves shirt and a bow up to a long-sleeved shirt, a bow and shorts." Line 31, remember change the word "interested" into the-ing form "interesting" and then rephrase the phrase "they create their unique dress" that is "their dress attractive."

The story is good but I'm sure your description about the two chimpanzees can be more than this writing. Look at line 2, Novita, remember when you write about someone or something, the age especially, "six month" is not the right way, you have to write "six months old." On the next line, that is the second line, you have the word "The second chimpanzee is seven month," again "seven months old," then "the second chimpanzee," change the word "chimpanzee" with the word "one," because you have already mentioned the word "The first chimpanzee" and "the second one," don't repeat the word "chimpanzee." The next sentence, "So they have same size," first I would like you to omit the word "so," change it with the word "However." Put the word "the" before "same size." OK now, keep this sentence and then continue first with the sentence four "The first chimpanzee is female and the second one is male." Now remember I want you to keep the third sentence, "However, they have the same size." Now I would like you to put the sentence behind the fourth sentence. So, it would go like this one: "The first chimpanzee is female and the second one is male. However, they have the same size." Line 5, "luxuriant feather", I don't think this is the right word because "feather" is for a bird, so use the word "fur" as you are. Check in your dictionary. And then for the word "luxuriant," I am not sure about this word, I think it is not right for used in this context, so try to find a more suitable word for that. Between line 5 and 6, delete the phrase "or their feather," just "The color is dark brown." That's enough. People will understand that the "color" refers to "the color of the fur." Line 7, "thick and big mouth," omit "thick and," then straight on with "big mouth," don't forget to add an indefinite article before "big mouth" and put a comma after that and you can add with the phrase "thick lips." You have no "thick mouth" but "thick lips." Delete the word "have," then add an indefinite article before the word "big," and the word "belly" with "e" not "a." After that I would like first you go to your last sentence on line 11 "They have long hands and short legs." I want you to move this sentence behind "a big belly," so "... a big belly full stop and then "They have long hands and short legs." Why would I want you to put the sentence there because once again you are still describing about the

physical appearance, so put the same kind description in one way. Ok. "Both of the chimpanzees," you don't have to say "the chimpanzees" again, change them into the word "them," because "both of them" when people regret they will automatically understand that "them" refers to "the chimpanzees." Line 7, the verb "liked' change it into present, because you are using present form from the first paragraph. Line 8, the word "branch," make it into plural. "on the branch of the free," I think what you means is "on the branches of the trees." Next, when you are looking at the picture, you will use present continuous, so not "hug" but "is hugging." The same thing with the line 9, change "hold" into present continuous "is holding," "a" not "the." Replace "the comma" with "a semicolon" because you are trying to combine two different sentences and then cross the "so." Again, on line10, change "smile" into present continuous. "With closing her eyes," this is not suitable for English expression, I think the more suitable expression is "with her eyes closed." Now, I want you to think of a word, synonym to "funny" on line 11, maybe "cute" or maybe you can find another word, so don't use the word "funny, funny..." all the time. Ok that's all. Thank you. Don't forget to revise your works and bring the revision with your folder and the cassette on the date of the interview. Good Luck!
