

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ABSTRACT

Listening, speaking, reading then writing constitute the fundamental order in language learning. However, among the four language skills, writing is considered to be the most difficult skill to be mastered especially for Senior High school students. Therefore, to make it easier for the students to master the writing skill, we can use reading comprehension passages. Reading is a receptive skill from which the students can get a lot of information.

The writer's consideration for using reading comprehension passages as a means to teach writing ís that reading passages as models can help the students to write step by step. Using reading passages as models can help students provide an idea and motivate them to write. Reading passages can help students learn the way to write such as organization, sentence connections, structure patterns, vocabularies, etc. In short, it can be said. using reading comprehension passages in teaching writing is indeed very useful.
