

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#### ABSTRACT

English as the first foreign language in Indonesia is taught formerly from Junior High School. However, to face the globalization era, there is a tendency to introduce English from the Elementary School to Senior High School, as there is a consideration that the best age to learn a language is at the age of two to fourteen years old (Lennerberg, 1966:1969).

As those ages, the language teaching method also influences the students' acquisition. While a teacher who teaches them should be able to look for a strategy which is suitable for the lesson given so that her way of teaching will not become boring for her students. For Elementary level, it is believed that the successfulness of the teaching is depended on the teacher's creativity. Therefore, a teacher should vary her ways of teaching such as using eclectic teaching so that her class will become lively.

On the other hand, classroom preparation takes an important role in the teaching-learning process as with out a good preparation the teaching-learning process would not be successful.

Therefore, it is quite necessary to make a neat and clear preparation so that the teacher knows what she should do in the classroom to make her .teaching lively

and interestingly.
