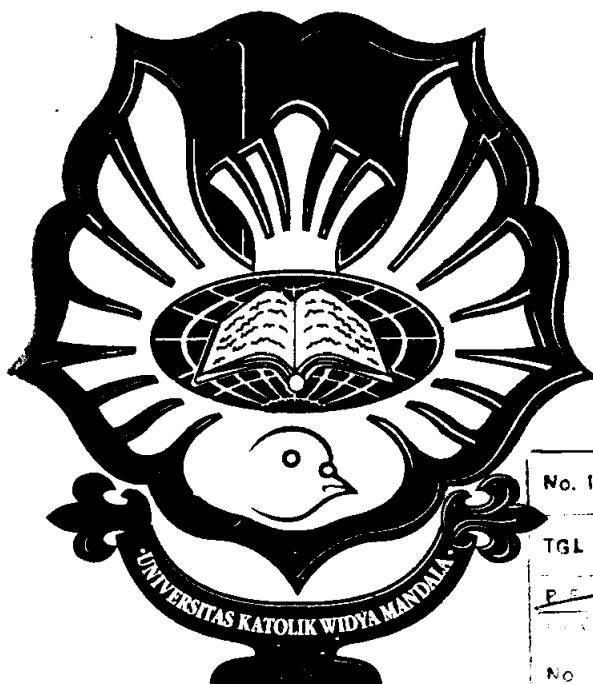





ABSTRACT

Literature begins in the creative possibilities of human language and the desire of human beings to use their language creatively. It means, language is the tool of human in creating literature.
