1.1. Background of The Problem

1.3. Objective of The Study

1.4. Scope and Limitation

The participants consisted of 15 students from the Morphology and Syntax class A English Department of Faculty of Teacher Training and Education, Batch 2017, who were assessed by Schoology for online assessment in their class. The writer takes that particular class only for the reason that it is the only one class which received online assessment for one semester.

1.5. Theoretical Framework

Assessing online using Schoology is a common practice nowadays for schools and universities. Using an online platform such as Schoology for homework, project submission, and material sharing is very helpful for both of them, the students and teacher. Ndadari and Karyawati (2016) in their research claim that most of the students taught using blended learning by Schoology improve their productive and receptive language skills. On the

other research, Holmes and Prieto-Rodriguez (2018) finds that the participants express greater appreciation toward the Learning Management System (LMS) since the interactivity supports features are easy to use; the face-to-face interaction and classroom discussion.
