#### Abstract

The writer chose Paulo Coelho's novel "By the River Piedra, I Sat Down and Wept" because there were internal conflict that happened to Pilar. These conflicts make the story very interesting.

The study under report tried to answer the following research questions: (1) What form of Internal conflict does Pilar experience? (2) Why does Pilar experience such internal conflict? (3) How does Pilar solve her internal conflict?

To answer the research questions, the writer read the novel three times to get a good understand of the story, then wrote and collected words, phrase sentences, and dialogs and analyzed them.
