

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

5.1 Conclusion

This research aims to answer two research questions which follow: “What are the challenges of inclusive education in the novel “Wonder”?” and “How do the characters cope with the challenges?”. This study found that the challenges faced by Auggie are discrimination and bullying. In case of bullying, there are several verbal bullying events, but no non-verbal or physical bullying events. Regarding the second research question, it was found that Auggie’s friends, and his school manage to solve bullying and discrimination: preventing bullying, and discrimination among disabled and normal students, responding and helping to solve students’ problems, and embracing student’s diversity.

Moreover, students, teachers, staff, and the principal of inclusive schools view disabled students as new and unique people similar to Auggie. Therefore, they accept and embrace their disability, and manage to help them when they have problems. It becomes their duty and responsibility to help disabled students and make them learn and play comfortably in class and school. Above all, the purpose of inclusive education is to combine all children to learn and play together despite their background and state. Combining disabled and normal children in the school can create togetherness, and friendship between them which already become the value of inclusive education (Stubbs, 2008).

5.2 Suggestions
