And this is the same with your sentence on line 4 - "He has brow wrinkling ..." For your sentence on line 5 - "Paul is very fat it can be seen from his physical performance" should be deleted it, because this is a repetition of line 1 and 2 "Pastor Paul was young but his belly was already spreading under his white Izod shirt." As a suggestion, you can add information there, for example "He was a Nigerian man," "He came from a church in Benue State."

Subjective:

Your subjective paragraph is original. Good job. However, you have some mistakes there. I think here you want to say “Most of them may have ...” Add the word “one” before the word “opinion,” so the sentence is “Most of them may have one opinion, that is Pastor Paul is the Holy man. Go to line 3, the word “because” should be changed with “That is because” in order to make it clear. Still on line 3, look at the conjunction “that,” change it with a subject pronoun “it” that refers to the clause “he likes to pray.” Now, see line 4; look for the right conjunction to change “if”. The word “closely” is an adverb word, whereas it should be an adjective word. See the different between adverbs and adjective in meaning. Consult your dictionary!

You have "every day" make it in conjunction, so don't write "everyday" separately, but together. You have mentioned about "smelling the bacon cooking and the garbage rotting," it should be mentioned why can you smell all those things, specific something to do with the location of your class. Explain more. Before the word "classroom" on line 11 I would like you to put a definite article. You can omit the word "friends" on line 12 and put the word "other" in plural. It will explain enough. "There isn't" because "isn't" negative, so use "any." Air conditioning or air conditioner? If you mention about the tool, it should be a noun, not in the verb. Line 12, "which can" just omit that one and change with a preposition "to." Not "condition" I think but "temperature", and not "of" but "in the classroom." Delete the to be "is" and go straight to the line 14. The word "comfort," since you are using an adjective, I would like you to look for in your dictionary for the adjective of "comfort." The sentence "It feels up to the chair," in my opinion, you had better move that sentence in another place there is on line 9 after the phrase "another is quite big." It means that you explains about chairs to the same subject. "I also sometimes up to music," I would like you to move this sentence into line 12 after the word "with the others." And the next one, between line 14 and 15, "I also sometimes hear the sounds of," you don't need to say "playing music" just "music." Now, where does the sound come form and how can you hear them? Explain that one. Line 15, "From the window" or "windows." Be careful! Line 16, you have the sentence "the floor made of creamy-white tiles." Are there many tiles? What you do with tiles in plural? For the word "made of" It is not right, may be "made of" should be "is covered with" Now "The floor up to tiles," I think it is better move that sentence into another part, that is behind line 6 "and very clean." The next "The shape up to square" between line 16 and 17, Are you sure about this one? You have mentioned before that the size is about 5 times 10 meters. I don't think it is square. Now, I would like you to combine the word "old" with the sentence on line 2. It becomes " My class is quite old and big." Don't use quite for the second time. Delete the article "the" and change the word "outside" in capital letter. Line 18. "In the classroom there is" Delete the phrase "in the classroom" and change "there" in the capital letter. Line 19, add an indefinite article before the word "vase." Next move this sentence into line 3 after the word "made of wood," because it should be discussed about this at the same time. Between line 19 and 20 "many of rooms" Delete the "of," so it becomes "many rooms." Line 20 If you talk about a certain room add a definite article before the word "canteen." The

sentence "The ceiling is also white." It is better for you to move this sentence into line 6 after word "very clean" Before the sentence "the floor is covered with creamy-white tiles." Because you have explained about the classroom's walls before, so it is better to talk about the ceiling color at the same time. Next, between line 20 and 21, "My feeling in the classroom is quite nice," maybe you can change this into "This classroom is quite nice for me." That's easier and more clear to understand. Then move this sentence at the last sentence as a conclusion. Line 21, "I bored " here you need a "to be." "Around the school there is also a police station," delete this sentence because you are explaining about your classroom not a police station. Next line 22 and 23, the sentence "there is a door which we can turn the other classroom," I think change it with "there is a door which links one class with another classroom." Line 23, delete the phrase "in every classroom," go straight with "there is also a speaker," put a comma "so we can hear the announcement from the headmaster." The last sentence on line 24 and 25, "In every up to representative" combine this with sentence on line 4 becomes "There are also many photos of heroes" comma "a photo the president and the vice president" Check in your dictionary for the writing of "vice president." Then move it to line 4, after the word "heroes."

Line 27, "I'm very room" once again that is the Indonesia expression change it into "I like my room very much." "I think" on line 27 you can change the indefinite article "a" with a definite article "the." so it becomes "the most comfortable place in the world," delete the phrase "for me" because you're already had there before that "I think" so you don't have to use "for me."

The next sentence, "So they have same size," first I would like you to omit the word "so," change it with the word "However." Put the word "the" before "same size." OK now, keep this sentence and then continue first with the sentence four "The first chimpanzee is female and the second one is male." Now remember I want you to keep the third sentence, "However, they have the same size." Now I would like you to put the sentence behind the fourth sentence. So, it would go like this one: "The first chimpanzee is female and the second one is male. However, they have the same size." Line 5, "luxuriant feather", I don't think this is the right word because "feather" is for a bird, so use the word "fur" as you are. Check in your dictionary. And then for the word "luxuriant," I am not sure about this word, I think it is not right for used in this context, so try to find a more suitable word for that. Between line 5 and 6, delete the phrase "or their feather," just "The color is dark brown." That's enough. People will understand that the "color" refers to "the color of the fur." Line 7, "thick and big mouth," omit "thick and," then straight on with "big mouth," don't forget to add an indefinite article before "big mouth" and put a comma after that and you can add with the phrase "thick lips." You have no "thick mouth" but "thick lips." Delete the word "have," then add an indefinite article before the word "big," and the word "belly" with "e" not "a." After that I would like first you go to your last sentence on line 11 "They have long hands and short legs." I want you to move this sentence behind "a big belly," so "... a big belly full stop and then "They have long hands and short legs." Why would I want you to put the sentence there because once again you are still describing about the

physical appearance, so put the same kind description in one way. Ok. "Both of the chimpanzees," you don't have to say "the chimpanzees" again, change them into the word "them," because "both of them" when people regret they will automatically understand that "them" refers to "the chimpanzees." Line 7, the verb "liked" change it into present, because you are using present form from the first paragraph. Line 8, the word "branch," make it into plural. "on the branch of the tree," I think what you means is "on the branches of the trees." Next, when you are looking at the picture, you will use present continuous, so not "hug" but "is hugging." The same thing with the line 9, change "hold" into present continuous "is holding," "a" not "the." Replace "the comma" with "a semicolon" because you are trying to combine two different sentences and then cross the "so." Again, on line 10, change "smile" into present continuous. "With closing her eyes." this is not suitable for English expression. I think the more suitable expression is "with her eyes closed." Now, I want you to think of a word, synonym to "funny" on line 11, maybe "cute" or maybe you can find another word. so don't use the word "funny, funny..." all the time. Ok that's all. Thank you.
