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

Researchers found that these things are interesting things, so this study was made to be able to contribute to ESG performance research based on previous research suggestions.	3
	Urgency and novelty are further clarified so that the novelty of this research appears	United Nations Principles for Responsible Investment (UN-PRI) invites investors to consider ESG performance when evaluating company performance, especially now that corporations' contribution to sustainable development is the main concern of investors, creditors, governments, and other environmental institutions (Atan et al. 2018).	2
2		This research related to ESG performance was carried out based on the suggestions data of previous studies, namely by using the ESG score from Thomson Reuters, in contrast to previous studies using the ESG score from Bloomberg. Also using a sample of all Indonesian companies listed on the IDX and Thomson Reuters respectively during the 2014-2019 period. This is a longer period because of the research gap in previous studies, as well as adding control variables, namely firm size and leverage. The results of research based on the use of different data with a longer period is expected to be a novelty for current research.	3

3		This study uses secondary data, namely quantitative data in the form of annual reports and ESG scores of all companies listed on the IDX (Indonesian Stock Exchange) and Thomson Reuters in 2014-2019, respectively. The company's annual report data is obtained through the website www.idx.co.id which is the official website of the IDX and the websites of each company, while the ESG score data is obtained through the website www.refinitiv.com which is the site where Thomson Reuters publishes its ESG score.	7
