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ABSTRACT

Some students like reading but some others do not. Most of them say the same reason why they do not like it. It takes a lot of time if they read a passage.

The purpose of this research is to see the reading achievement of second grade students of junior high school. The research question is: How is the second grade students of junior high school reading achievement?

The design was quantitative and non-experimental study. The subjects of this study were 71 students of grade two at Junior High School. The instrument of this study was a reading test made by the researcher herself.

The result of this study was that the mean of reading test score was 71 meanwhile the standard of the school was 75.
